Rosé wines

Conto Vecchio Pinot Grigio Blush 2009 Italy £16.50

The nose is fruity, slightly floral and pleasant; particularly crisp and balanced palate.

Delicato Family Vineyards Zinfandel Rosé 2008 USA £21.50

Off dry, with plenty of raspberry and watermelon fruit flavours. Juicy and light, it has a refreshing bright acidity on the finish.

Red wines

Wandering Bear Merlot 2009 USA £14.00

Ripe plum and damson fruit with a tiny bit of cinnamon profile from some oak influences, no harsh tannins and with a long quality finish.

Alto Bajo Merlot Valle Central 2009 Chile £15.00

Nose of herbs, freshly picked red berries and green pepper corn. Soft, medium body, round and elegant with a persistent finish.

Saam Mountain Paarl Shiraz 2008 South Africa £17.50

Plum, black berry and spicy nose is carried on to the palate where it fills one's mouth with juicy tannins and ripe, dark, sweet fruit.

Agustinos Pinot Noir Reserva Privada 2009 Chile £19.50

Strawberry, cherry fruit and a touch of cedar wood on the nose. Fresh palate with good fruit and sweetness, a touch of aromatic tea, with nice grippy tannins.

Thesaurum Corvina Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 Italy £21.00

Cherries, violets and cassis and the nose. Northern Italian wine with bright with deep black olive and blackberry flavours and subtle peppery spice.

Altas de Ruesca Garnacha Calatuyud 2009 Spain £21.50

Rich and forward concentrated with ripe, red fruit flavours and hints of spicy blackberries, plums and oak.

Chianti Rufina Fattoria di Basciano 2007 Italy £25.50

Concentrated plum and refreshing red cherry flavours with full-body, soft tannins and a long, fruity, peppery finish.

Fleurie Mommessin Cru Beaujolais 2008 France £26.00

Cru Beaujolais at its best, ripe primary red fruit characters with hints of cherry.

Château Lugagnac Bordeaux Superieur 2006 France £27.00

Claret from the left bank, complex, full-bodied wine with well defined berry/plum fruit aromas and flavours and integrated spicy oak.

Côtes du Rhône Villages Cairanne 2007 France £32.00

A Blend of Syrah, Grenache and Carignan a gamey, meaty, smoked herb notes interwoven with kirsch and spice box. Dense, elegant, pure, and flavourful.
